Swiss Army to purchase O C E A N Telecine Controller for Cintel Millennium HD

Bern, Switzerland - Marquise Technologies announced today the installation of O C E A N Telecine controller at the Swiss Federal Department of Defense.

In the Electronic Media Centre (EMC) is archived more than 60 years of Swiss military history. EMC has acquired a year ago a Cintel Millennium HD telecine for the digitalization of more than 3'000 16mm and 35 mm film rolls, and an imageMill GRACE for grain reduction.

These archives are digitalized in ProRes 4:4:4, in order to create a HD Master, which can further be used for DVD encoding, or for Web or TV broadcast.

Film transfer expert Kathrin Schneider has a heavy grading process of the old film rolls to perform, in order to restore the green or blue channels that are usually damaged over the years: "Having O C E A N is a great improvement in our workflow" Kathrin explained. "The telecine is now a lot easier to operate at its full capabilities and all our grading and degrain tools are now accessible within the same interface".

"As a Swiss company we are of course very honored to have been chosen by the Federal Department of Defense, but beyond that, the EMC had needs that our solution could answer in terms of support, quality and efficiency, and that is the most important" says Laurence Stoll, CEO of Marquise Technologies.

Installation has been done with the support of Cintel International, who has been involved in the process from the beginning, in order to guaranty the smoothest integration between the Millennium, the imageMill and O C E A N.
